The series consists of 75 issues in total – 66 regular, monthly issues, five one-shot specials, and a four-issue Preacher: Saint of Killers limited series. The final monthly issue, number 66, was published in October 2000. The entire run has been collected in three series of trade paperbacks, an original run of PREACHER #1-12 – plus pinups from PREACHER #50 and #66 – are collected in this new paperback that introduces Preacher Jesse Custer, Cassidy and Tulip.
